

You won't hear his mother cry, either.

Her husband said "You don't have a choice," the doctor said "Shut up," her friends said "Get over it."

A week after the abortion, she did.

Suicide rates are 6 times higher after abortion. Women are often dismissed when they insist they don't want an abortion and then silenced afterward. 65% suffer trauma.

Their pain is often minimized or denied ... even by experts.

"[The abortionist] asked three nurses to hold me while he strapped me to the bed. I continued to scream that I didn't want an abortion. He told me, "Shut up and quit that yelling!" -Denise

"She was crying as she entered the clinic, she cried throughout the procedure, and was sobbing as she left. Her three children are growing up without their mom because no one wanted to ask questions." -Julie, sister of suicide victim

"I leaned on my boyfriend when my dad moved away. He controlled everything I did." –Lana
"I wanted so much for someone to say 'I will help you ...' " –Kate

"My dad moved to another state and my mother was sick. My boyfriend slapped me around and controlled everything I did. My brother was the one who took me to the abortion clinic." -Lana

"I wanted so much to talk to someone who would say 'I will help you through this, there is help available.' ... Instead I was herded with about 10 other girls like cattle. They said to even think of keeping 'it' was selfish." -Sue

Susanne used to ride horses in California...



After the abortion, she needed a different way to get around.

"Get in touch with my dad. Tell him I love him."
Women are 3.5 times more likely to die within a year after abortion.

Susanne walked into the abortion clinic, but left on a stretcher. There was no anesthesiologist when the barbiturate they gave her sent her into cardiac arrest. Without oxygen, Susanne lapsed into a coma. After four months, she awoke in a nursing home, unable to talk and paralyzed from the neck down. Three years later, she died of pneumonia. Her last words were typed on a voice synthesizer: "Get in touch with my dad. Tell him I love him." State law did not permit Maryland officials to prosecute the abortionist or the clinic, which grossed an estimated \$10 million in 5 years. 

Homicide is the leading killer of pregnant women.

Mary's husband destroyed their home and ordered her to "Get rid of it. Now!" Julie's parents locked her in the house for two weeks and then drove her to the abortion clinic. Sandra's husband said he'd leave her if she didn't abort. Coercion can escalate to violence. In Massachusetts, a clinic security guard testified that boyfriends and husbands routinely threaten women to make sure they keep their abortion appointments. A New York woman was forcibly injected with an abortifacient by the baby's father ... a Georgia woman's husband jumped on her stomach to force an abortion.
