## **Sample Headline: Special Event Planned at Local Library** Local grief counselor to discuss abortion's impact on women, men and families.

"Every day, we talk with a number of women who struggle with the aftereffects of pregnancy loss, especially abortion," said Ms. Carter. "Many did not want the abortion and are experiencing significant clinical depression and trauma in its aftermath. Others have been dismissed by experts, family and friends and may resort to substance abuse and self-destructive behavior to cope. They need to know they are not alone in what they have experienced and in what they are feeling. They need to know that healing is possible."

Materials will include fact sheets about widespread unwanted or coerced abortions, which can magnify post-abortion suffering, as well as facts about the significant risks and aftereffects of abortion.

"A growing number of studies verify that abortion is linked to elevated rates of psychological distress," Carter added. "Any pregnancy loss is a significant event that requires a unique grieving process."

Many experts who study pregnancy loss — especially abortion — have said that more research needs to be done. They note that a major longitudinal study of abortion complications, which was recommended by then-Surgeon General C. Everett Koop in 1988, has still never been done.

"Americans deserve accurate information," said Dr. David Reardon, director of the Elliot Institute, a leader in postabortion research, education and outreach. "Dr. Koop properly identified the way in which data could be gathered to examine all interactions between women's physical and mental health, including not only reactions to abortion, but also to study PMS, postpartum depression, menopause, and more.

"The only reason we don't have better answers today is because his research recommendation was rejected in Congress," said Reardon. "The political battle over abortion has blocked good federally funded research in this area."
